Candidates who are ABD will be considered, but candidates who will complete the doctorate by the time of appointment are strongly preferred. Successful candidates must demonstrate a strong commitment to both teaching and research.

The field of specialization is International Political Economy. We are particularly interested in candidates with a geographic focus in Asia and/or Africa. In addition to upper-division courses in these areas, teaching responsibilities will include Introduction to International Relations and/or Introduction to Comparative Government. Full review of applications will begin December 10, and the position will remain open until filled.
