

Research Assistantships Available

2 research assistant positions are available, starting immediately and extending during the full academic year (9 hours per week). The positions are open to students enrolled in graduate programs in political science and other parts of campus in the coming year, and we especially seek students who are able to continue working during the summer of 2010 and beyond.

The RAs will work with Professors Emilie Hafner-Burton and David G. Victor, co-leaders of the new UCSD laboratory on International Law and Regulation (ILAR): <http://ilar.ucsd.edu/>. The laboratory is exploring the ways that international law & regulatory arrangements influence behavior-both in theory and across several major issue-areas.

Each RA will be responsible for mapping existing scholarship in an issue-area: the environment or international arms control and security. Although each RA will be responsible for their own work, all RAs will work together as a team and contribute to ILAR's core research agenda. A background in studying (or practicing) international law or regulation is desirable but not essential.
